

# Carmen Sandiego's Great Chase Through Time

## Beginner

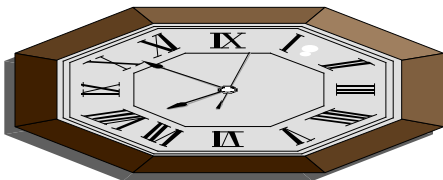
Let's start packing. We're in charge of saving history. In this activity our job is to capture Carmen and her crooks!

Carmen and her villains are back at it again. She and her crooks have stolen the Acme Chronoskimmer, a top-secret time traveling device. With this device Carmen and her villains have traveled back in time and have stolen priceless historical treasures.

We must stop those hoodlums right in their tracks!

Otherwise, the removal of those precious treasures could change the course of history.

What would we do if the crooks went back in time and stole all the toilets? Just think about that! What would we use today? How would the absence of toilets change our history?



Time pilot, your first adventure takes place in Ancient Egypt.

1. You must assist a priest in the mummification process of the Pharaoh. This will allow for a proper burial.

2. You must find and capture the crook that has stolen the Book of the Dead.

\*Remember in order to arrest your crook, you must complete the Carmen note and unravel the riddle. For clues on solving the riddle, refer to the handy dandy Acme Chronopedia. This book provides you with information about the time period and location you have traveled to.

\*Acme has assigned to you trusted assistants. They are there to help and will answer questions.

\*Make sure to explore your surroundings for clues and information!

Your Second adventure will take place in Ancient Rome. You will talk with Julius Caesar to find out what the trouble is and assist to remedy the problem. Note: If you wish to QUIT or SAVE your game, move the cursor to the left side of the screen.

The cursor will turn into a triangle. Click; this will give you game options.



## **Intermediate Level**

This is your opportunity to learn more about Ancient Egypt and Italy. In this activity you can choose to read anything that interests you about Egypt or Italy. The choices range from food and daily activities to religion and mummification. Once you have read, write a short letter to Supernova about something interesting you have learned.

Supernova will be thrilled to hear about your adventures through time!

Feel free to share the information with others in the class. If you have any questions, ask a Supernova Assistant (mentor).

## Expert Level

Now it is TIME to catch the rest of Carmen's crooks. As you travel through time you will learn new information about our past. Make sure that you click on things that are of interest to you for more information. You will travel to past Empires and Dynasties. You will also learn about different rulers and leaders. This is your TIME to learn more about our past and the people of the past.

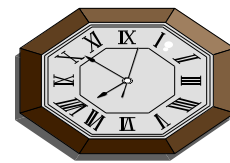
In this activity you will catch as many crooks as possible. You also have two other responsibilities.

1. As you get steps closer to finding Carmen Sandiego, the levels become more challenging. It is your job to write down some clues or hints for your fellow Expedition peers. You can write them in your journals/Expedition Logs or in a letter to Supernova. Supernova will then pass them on.
2. Once you have traveled the past, pick a period which interests you most. Once you have chosen a time, think about what it would be like for you to during that time.

Write a short story to Supernova about what you would be doing if you lived in that time period.

Think about what was going on in that time, how people dressed, what they ate. Would you would be a noble, or a peasant?
